CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed, absorbed through skin or inhaled. Avoid breathing vapor or spray mist. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide is highly toxic to birds and aquatic invertebrates. For terrestrial uses, do not apply directly to water, or to areas where surface water is present or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters. Cover or incorporate spilled treated seeds.

Resistance Management

Some insects are known to develop resistance to insecticides after repeated use. As with any insecticide, the use of this product should conform to resistance management strategies established for the use area.

Gaicho 75 ST FS contains a Group 4A insecticide. Insect biotypes with acquired or inherent resistance to Group 4A insecticides may eventually dominate the insect population if Group 4A insecticides are used repeatedly as the predominant method of control for targeted species.

The active ingredient in Gaicho 75 ST FS is a member of the neonicotinoid chemical class. Insect pests resistant to other chemical classes have not shown cross-resistance to Gaicho 75 ST FS. In order to maintain susceptibility to this class of chemistry in insect species with high resistance development potential, it is recommended that for each crop season: 1) only a single seed application of

Gaicho or other soil applied neonicot. 1) product be made to a crop; 2) foliar applica s of products from this same class not be made following a soil application of other neonicotinoid products.

Other Group 4A, neonicotinoid products used as foliar treatments include: Actara, Assail, CALYPSO, Centric, Clutch, Couraze, Gallant, Impulse, Intruder, LEVERAGE, Nuprid, Pasada, PROVADO, TRIMAX PRO and Venom.

Other Group 4A, neonicotinoid products used as soil/seed treatments include: Advise, Alias, Belay, Couraze, Cruiser, ADMIRE PRO, Macho, Macho Max, Nuprid, Platinum, Venom and Widow.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

For use in commercial seed treaters only.

This product is to be used in treaters designed for pelleting or coating seed. Mix thoroughly before use or use entire container at one time. For treatment of cucurbit seed destined for export to Mexico

Cucurbits:

To provide early season protection of seedlings against injury by early season whitefly (*Bemisia tabaci*), apply 47 grams per one kilcgram of seed prior to planting as a slurry treatment so far as to ensure thorough coverage.

For treatment of tomato and pepper seed destined for export to Mexico

Tomato and Pepper:

To provide early season protection of seedlings against injury by early season whitefly (*Bemisia tabaci*), apply 65.3 grams per one kilogram of seed prior to planting as a slurry treatment so far as to ensure thorough coverage.
