Trifloxystrobin Flowable Fungicide is currently registered as a seed treatment for control of seedborne fungi causing seed decay and soilborne pathogens, *Rhizoctonia solani* infecting a number of crops. With this application form, we are notifying the Agency that we are adding claims for control of *Fusarium* spp.

As required by PR Notice 98-10 we are enclosing one copy of draft labeling, dated June 22, 2007, in which the disease *Fusarium* spp. is highlighted in yellow. In addition, we are also enclosing two copies of final printed labeling. There are no other changes in the currently registered label.

This notification is consistent with the provision of PR Notice 98-10 and EPA regulations at 40 CFR 152.46, and no other changes have been made to the labeling or the confidential statement of formula of this product. I understand that it is a violation of 18 U.S.C. Sec. 1001 to willfully make any false statement to EPA. I further understand that if this notification is not consistent with the terms of PR Notice 98-10 and 40 CFR 152.46, this product may be in violation of FIFRA, and I may be subject to enforcement action and penalties under sections 12 and 14 of FIFRA.

- Do not use for feed, food or oil processing.
- Store away from feeds and other foodstuffs.

### GENERAL INFORMATION

TRIFLOXYSTROBIN Flowable Fungicide provides seed and seedling protection against seedborne fungi causing seed decay and soilborne pathogens, *Rhizoctonia solani* and *Fusarium* spp. Apply as a seed treatment using standard slurry or mist-type seed treatment equipment. Uniform application of seed is necessary to ensure seed safety and best disease protection. Seed should be sound and well cured prior to treatment. Product should be diluted with sufficient water to ensure complete seed coverage. Consult a seed treatment specialist regarding slurry rates recommended for the crop to be treated with TRIFLOXYSTROBIN Flowable Fungicide. The length of control will vary depending on the rate used.

### USE RESTRICTION

Do not use treated seed for food, feed, or oil processing.

### USE PRECAUTION

When using formulations that do not contain dye, to comply with 40 CFR 153.155, all seed treated with an economic poison must be colored to distinguish it and prevent subsequent inadvertent use as a food for man or feed for animals.
