To Whom It May Concern:

As allowed by PR Notice 98-10, we are notifying the Agency of a minor labeling amendment for Four Way Peanut Seed Treatment Fungicide (EPA Reg. No. 264-998). As required by California Proposition 65, the following statement has been added to the label: "This product contains a chemical known to the state of California to cause developmental or reproductive harm."

"This notification is consistent with the provisions of PR Notice 98-10 and EPA regulations at 40 CFR 152.46, and no other changes have been made to the labeling or the confidential statement of formula of this product. I understand that it is a violation of 18 U.S.C. Sec. 1001 to willfully make false statement to EPA. I further understand that if this notification is not consistent with the terms of PR Notice 98-10 and 40 CFR 152.46, this product may be in violation of FIFRA and I may be subject to enforcement action and penalties under sections 12 and 14 of FIFRA."

LABELLING OF TREATED SEED

Seed commercially treated with Four Way Peanut Seed Treatment Fungicide must be labeled in accordance with all applicable requirements of the Federal Seed Act. All bags containing treated seed must be labeled or tagged as follows:

- This seed has been treated with the pesticides, captan, trifloxystrobin, thiophanate-methyl, and metalaxyl.
- · Do not use for feed, food or oil processing.
- Store away from feeds and foodstuffs.
- Seed that has been treated with this product must also contain the following labeling:
- "This bag contains seed treated with captan. Persons opening this bag or loading/pouring the treated seed must wear long-sleeved shirt, long pants, shoes, socks, and chemical-resistant gloves."

APPLICATION INFORMATION

Four Way Peanut Seed Treatment Fungicide is a special formulation developed for dry application to peanut seed. It is used for protection against seedborne and soilborne fungi causing seed rots and seedling blights, including *Rhizoctonia solani*, *Pythium spp.*, *Rhizopus spp.*, *Fusarium spp.*, *Aspergillus spp.*, seedborne Cylindrocladium black rot (CBR), and seedborne *Sclerotinia* and fungi causing seed decay.

Peanuts

Use 4-5 ounces per 100 pounds of seed. Apply with a standard commercial treating machine designed for dry formulations that provides uniform coverage to seed.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage, disposal, or by cleaning of equipment.

PESTICIDE STORAGE

Store in cool, dry location.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL

Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal law.
