On the basis of information furnished by the registrant, the above named pesticide is hereby registered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide: Act.

Be advised that the current database for this chemical supports only those uses present on this approved label. Should you wish to expand the current use pattern, the submission of additional data would likely be necessary and will be subject to PRIA. The studies listed below have been identified as

likely to be necessary to support any scenario that would result in increased exposure:

- 1. (835.4300) Aerobic Aquatic Metabolism Study: an additional acceptable aerobic aquatic study on a different water:sediment system including the exploration of multiple solvent extraction systems.
- 2. (850.2300) Avian Reproductive Study on Mallard Duck: current data on mallard duck were inadequate to derive a definitive NOAEC or make a definitive determination of risk. A second avian reproduction study on mallard duck would reduce uncertainty and obviate the need to presume risk to this taxon.




