DIRECTIONS FOR

It is a violation of federal law to use in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Shake well before each use. Remove food. Aim spray opening away from person to spray.

Food should be removed or carefully treated. All food processing surfaces should be covered before treatment or thoroughly cleaned before using. In food processing plants, when plants are not in operation.

FOR HOUSEFLIES, MOSQUITOES AND SPIDERS: Open doors and windows. Point nozzle and spray mist to all parts of the room, including windows and other light sources where insects hide. Fill the room with mist, then close doors and windows. Keep the room closed for 15 minutes. Ventilate the room when completed.

WASPS: Application should be made when insects are at rest. Spray liberally in nesting and breeding places, contacting as many wasps as possible. Repeat as necessary.

FOR CRAWLING INSECTS: Roaches, crickets, mites, sowbugs, spiders and centipedes. Thoroughly into hiding places such as crevices, moist areas, openings around doors, sinks, under refrigerators, baseboard areas. Spray directly on insects. Repeat as necessary.

ANTS: Spray trails, nests and points of entry. Repeat as necessary.
