

DIRECTIONS

Shake well before and during use. Make sure spout is pointed away from you before releasing spray. Release spray by pressing plunger valve down.

TO CONTROL SCREW-WORM

spray from 3 inches away, directly into and 1 inch around infested wound, also the drainage area below wound. Treatment should be repeated twice weekly until wounds heal. Not effective in some populations or strains of screw worms which are resistant to this product.

TO CONTROL FLEECE-WORMS

and other secondary blow flies, spray from 3 inches away, directly into infested wound. Also treat an area 2 to 3 inches surrounding wound. Treatment should be repeated twice weekly until wounds heal.

TO PROTECT WOUNDS

against screw-worm, fleece worm and other secondary blow flies. Spray all wounds, such as shear cuts, wire cuts, and after DEHORNING, DOCKING or CASTRATING. Treatment should be repeated twice weekly until wounds heal.

TO CONTROL EAR-TICK

grasp animal's ear firmly with one hand and fire the other to release spray downward into animal's ear. A 3 second application is recommended for larger animals, 2 seconds for smaller animals. Do not use on calves under 3 months of age.

Penetrates masses of ear wax and rapidly kills Ear Ticks, Ear Mites and Mites. Protects against reinfestation for 3 weeks or more.

PRECAUTIONS

Do not use this product on any cattle. Do not use this product on sheep. Do not use more than necessary, especially on young calves. Do not use on any sheep.

CAUTION: Harmful to eyes. Avoid inhalation and skin contact. May penetrate through skin. If material is sprayed in face, immediately wash thoroughly.

WARNING: Do not use under pressure. Do not puncture. Do not use in near heat or open flame. Explosive temperatures at 20-130° Fahrenheit may cause bursting. Never throw or take into fire or incinerator.
