- 2. Change the 1f On Skin section of the Statement of Practical Treatment to read "Wash with plenty of soap and water. Get medical attention if irritation persists."
- 3. Previous data on file indicate that this formulation is, in all probability, a severe dernal irritant. Therefore, you must submit a dermal irritation study, Guidelines Reference No. 81-5, within one (1) year of receipt of this letter.
