The proposed amendment to the registration of the product cited above under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act removing the active ingredient, MGK-11, and increasing the amount of another active ingredient, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

1. Submit the product-specific product chemistry and the data matrix for the new formulation. Refer to comment 8 below. The chemistry data must be generated on the formula you ultimately decide upon.
2. Provide the chemical identity of the inert ingredient, Trisolan. Include the CAS Number and a Material Safety Data Sheet.
3. Submit a complete description of the formulation process. Describe the equipment used, mixing time, temperature, etc.
4. Submit a brief description of impurities formed during the manufacturing/formulation process, in packaging, or during storage. If you do not expect any impurities during these stages, please so state.
5. Provide the analytical methods used to analyze for the active ingredients or a full reference for a published method or MRID Number.

6. Submit a 1-year storage stability study. The formulated product must be analyzed for its active ingredients at time zero and during a year of storage. The storage must be under warehouse conditions of temperature and humidity using containers similar to those that will be used in the trade. This data must be submitted within 15 months of the date of this letter.
7. Add the statement "Harmful if swallowed" to the precautionary labeling.
8. Refer to the Data Call-In Notice for Methylene Chloride dated September 29, 1988. Since no one supported the chemical, it is no longer acceptable in pesticide formulations. You must remove the methylene chloride and substitute another chemical in its place.

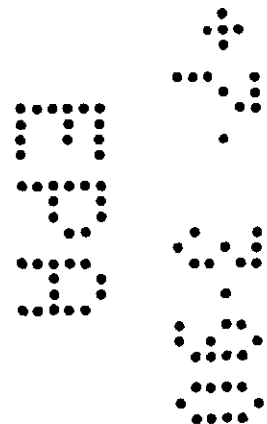
