AUTOMATIC DUSTING STATIONS

For control of hornflies on dairy cattle and beef cattle and as a aid in the control of lice on dairy cattle, 3% Dieldrin Insecticide Dust may be applied daily when application is made with Automatic Dusting Stations. Install automatic dusters near mineral and salt blocks, at alleyways leading to and from the dairy barn. Dusters may also be installed in livestock holding pens, feed lots, and loafing sheds where possible.

HAND AND POWER DUSTERS

For the control of hornflies on beef and lactating dairy animals, apply 1-2 heaping tablespoonsful to the backline of the animal, covering in addition the poll, neck, and upper portions of the sides. Repeat above application as necessary to maintain control, but no more often than once every 14 days. Wash hands thoroughly after use. For the control of lice on dairy cattle treat animals thoroughly. If required repeat this thorough application in 3-4 weeks.

CAUTIONS: Humans: Keep out of reach of children. Avoid prolonged repeated inhalation of dust and contact with skin or eyes. In case of contact with skin or eyes, flush with plenty of water, for eyes get medical attention. Keep away from open flame. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating or smoking. Do not contaminate feed, water, or foodstuffs. Do not contaminate any body of water by direct application, cleaning of equipment, or disposal of dust or containers. If swallowed, induce vomiting immediately and get medical attention. Antidote: none.

Livestock: Do not treat calves and young kids of age. Do not treat sheep should not be treated at all, since they may show hypersensitivity to organic phosphates.

DESTROY USED CONTAINERS. Do not reuse for any purpose. Do not burn containers by burning or burying in unisolated area. If burned, avoid inhalation of smoke.
