The Agency, in accordance with the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, has completed reviewing all of the information submitted with your application to support the reregistration of the above referenced product in connection with the Piperonyl Butoxide, Pyrethrins, and Di-n-propyl Isocinchomeronate REDs, and has concluded that your submission is acceptable.

NOTE: This product is **not** being reregistered under sections 3(c)5 and 4(g) of FIFRA at this time.

Please note that, should you wish to add a reference to the company's website on your label, the website becomes labeling under FIFRA and is subject to review by the Agency.
