The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. One copy of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment.

Add the following footnote to the ingredient statement:
Contains petroleum distillate

Revise the 6th sentence of the precautionary statements to read as follows:
Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling.

As this product contains petroleum distillate, the first aid statements must read as follows:
If Swallowed: Immediately call a poison control center or doctor. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor. Do not give any liquid to the person. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

Add a Note to Physician as follows:
Note to physician: Contains petroleum distillate – vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia.

Revise the last sentence of the directions for use to read as follows:
Do not use on horses intended for slaughter.
