To Kill Carpet Beetles—To destroy carpet beetles, use a carpet beetle powder. Sprinkle the powder in the crevices of the carpet, under the furniture, and in the closets. Vacuum the powder up after 24 hours. Repeat the treatment every 7 days for 3 weeks. A vacuum cleaner with a HEPA filter is best for this job. Wash the vacuum cleaner's bag or canister after each use.

To Kill Fleas and Brown Dog Ticks—Fleas and ticks are the most common parasites of dogs and cats. Fleas cause allergic reactions in some animals, and both fleas and ticks can transmit diseases. Brown dog ticks are especially dangerous because they can transmit ehrlichiosis, a potentially fatal disease. Fleas and ticks can also cause anemia in young animals. The best way to control fleas and ticks is by using a topical treatment. Topical treatments are applied to the back of the neck, where the animal cannot reach them. They kill fleas and ticks by paralyzing them. Topical treatments are also effective against ear mites and ear infections. They are safe for use on dogs and cats, and they are easy to apply. Topical treatments are available in a variety of brands and formulations. Some are available over the counter, while others require a prescription. Talk to your veterinarian about the best topical treatment for your animal.
