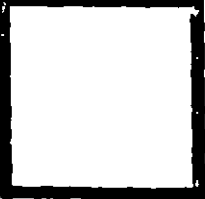

1. Remove cap and drop one KARTRIDGE into KANE.
2. Fill KANE with water.
3. Replace cap on KANE and mix gently until KARTRIDGE dissolves.
4. Adjust nozzle for proper spray size.
5. Put KANE tip on weed, push down and release quickly, wetting weed thoroughly.
6. Complete kill of broadleaf weeds in 1 to 2 weeks.
7. Rinse KANE out after using.

**NOTE:** Application to bent grass, St. Augustine, carpet grass, dichondra, or clover may cause injury. May damage grass seedlings.

## STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

**STORAGE:** Store in dry place. Do not store near fertilizers, seeds, insecticides or fungicides.

**DISPOSAL:** Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.
