**Precautionary Statements**  
**Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals**  
**CAUTION**  
 Harmful if swallowed, inhaled, or absorbed through the skin. Avoid breathing of mist. Avoid contact with skin or eyes. Avoid contamination of food and foodstuffs. Do not use in edible product areas of food processing plants, restaurants, or other areas where food is commercially prepared or processed. Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums and house plants before spraying.

**If on Skin:** Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water.  
**If in Eyes:** Flush eyes for at least 1/2 minutes with water. Call a physician immediately.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**  
**STORAGE:** Store in cool, dry area away from heat or open flame.  
**DISPOSAL:** Do not re-use empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.

**PREPARATION:** Cover asphalt tile, waxed wood floors and furniture. Open all cabinets, closets and interior doors to areas to be treated. Remove pets and cover or remove fish tanks and bowls. Cover exposed foods, dishes, and food handling equipment. Close outside doors and windows; turn off fans and air conditioning; extinguish all open flames except pilot light.

**TO KILL TICKS:** Remove and destroy old pet bedding before treatment. Treat dogs and cats with a registered tick control product before allowing them to enter treated area.

**DIRECTIONS:** Set Fog-A-Bug II on table, chair or stand at least six feet from pilot light. Place several layers of newspaper under canister to prevent marring of surface. Remove canister cover. Hold can at arms length, aiming top of can away from face. Press lever down firmly until it locks — this will start fogging action. Set fogger in upright position on newspaper, and leave the building at once, closing exterior door. Leave undisturbed for two hours, then open exterior doors and windows and allow to air for 30 minutes before reoccupying area.
