STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

In eyes — Flush for at least 15 minutes with water. Call a physician if irritation persists.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL

Do not reuse empty container. Destroy it by perforating or crushing. Bury or discard in a safe place.

HORSES & PONIES: For control of biting or sucking lice, ticks, flies and gnats on horses and ponies, dust directly onto all parts of animal's body, working in dust by brushing against the lay of the hair to bring dust into contact with the skin. For best results give special attention to neck, mane, tail and flanks. Repeat as necessary, but not more often than once a week.

DOGS & CATS: For control of ticks, ticks and lice on dogs and cats, apply powder liberally to body, working in dust by brushing against the lay of the hair, allowing dust to penetrate to the skin. For best results give special attention to areas where hair is long and thick. Repeat as necessary but not more often than once a week.

Do not treat puppies or kittens less than four weeks of age.

For kennels and animal quarters, dust bedding and floors to prevent reinfestation.

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
