



DIRECTIONS FOR USE

DOGS & CATS: Apply powder liberally to body, working in dust by brushing against the lay of the hair, allowing dust to penetrate to the skin. For best results give special attention to areas where hair is long and thick. Repeat as necessary.

KENNELS & ANIMAL QUARTERS: Dust bedding and floor to prevent reinfestation.

CARPETS, MATS & RUGS: To aid in the control of fleas as well as freshen both the carpet and room air in one easy step, simply sprinkle Nature's Own Herbal Repellent Flea Powder on carpets, mats and rugs by shaking container from side to side. Wait 1 hour, allowing dust to penetrate the carpeting, and then vacuum up dust. **IMPORTANT:** Be sure all carpet is thoroughly covered with powder, including along baseboards, behind and under furniture and around door jams. For best results use at least once a week. In areas of high humidity, more frequent treatment may be necessary. Avoid use on wet spots. If product adheres to spot, simply rub with a stiff nylon brush and vacuum.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store tightly closed in cool dry place away from heat and sunlight.
