SPRAY APPLICATIONS: Thoroughly spray all leaves, bark, and twigs susceptible to damage from rabbits, deer, and meadow voles. For best results in protecting new growth, it may be necessary to apply this product every 2-5 days. To protect dormant trees following leaf fall, spray twigs and trunk to the height of 5 feet. Apply product under conditions of no precipitation and low humidity to allow the repellent film to set up properly. After use, rinse sprayer thoroughly with water to prevent clogging.

BRUSH APPLICATION: Using a small clean paint brush apply a thin coating of product to leaves, bark and twigs susceptible to damage by rabbits, deer, and voices. Rinse brush promptly and thoroughly. Applications every 2-5 days may be needed to protect new growth. Rinse brush promptly and thoroughly after use.
