**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Use precautions: When diluting with water, prepare only the amount needed for immediate use. Holding a water dilution more than 24 hours is not recommended.

**ON GROWING CROPS:** May be used on edible crops (outdoors or in the greenhouses) up to and including day of harvest. Especially desirable as a clean-up or pre-harvest spray where other materials may not be used due to residue restrictions. When applied according to accepted use of cautions and directions this concentrate may be used in combination with other insecticides where resistant insects are a problem or as an "exciter" to flush insects out of hiding and into contact with spray residues.

On the following crops to control named insects, use 1 Uni-Bottle per 1/2 gallon water to cover approximately 200 sq. ft. Coverage of upper and lower leaf surfaces is essential for good control.
