A. Revised CSF

B. Revised Label

### FOR CONTROL OF CLOTHES MOTHS

**Use Restrictions:** For control of eggs, larvae, and adults of clothes moths in containers, garment bags, and storage closets designed to be air tight. Do not use in containers, dry cleaning and garbage bags, or closets that allow vapors to escape into occupied rooms. Do not use this Naphthalene-containing products with any other moth control chemical. For use only on cloth containing wool or wool blends.

**Application Directions:** Before storing, dry clean, wash or brush articles to be protected. Store only in a clean, air tight container (e.g., trunk, chest), garment bag, or storage closet. Apply at the following rates:

Keep product in container, bag, or closet for a minimum of seven (7) days. Odor dissipates when treated articles are aired.

Retreatment: Since moths are active all year, replenish containers, bags, and closets 2 times a year.

### **FOR CONTROL OF TREE SQUIRRELS, BATS, STARLINGS, PIGEONS, AND HOUSE SPARROWS**

**Use Restrictions:** To repel tree squirrels, bats, starlings, pigeons, and house sparrows from attics and wall voids.

**Application Directions:** Spread flakes on floor or apply between walls, using about 1 pound for every 400 cubic feet. Tree squirrels, bats, and birds will depart from treated space within a short time, after which all openings through which they gain entrance, such as small crevices around eaves, bases of rafters, around dormers, should be closed by means of strips of wood, metal or by the use of oakum.

#### **STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

**Storage:** Store only in original container, in a dry place away from heat and sunlight and inaccessible to children and pets.

**Disposal:** Do not reuse empty container. Securely wrap in newspaper and discard in trash.
