- c. Revise the Statement of Practical Treatment to read as follows:

IF ON SKIN: Wash with plenty of soap and water. Get medical attention.

IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth. Get medical attention.

IF IN EYES: Flush with plenty of water. Call a physician if irritation persists.

IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or Poison Control Center. Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

- d. Revise the last sentence of the Environmental Hazards Statements to read as follows:

"Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters."

- e. Revise the last sentence of the Storage and Disposal Statements to read:

"Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash."

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING

Not for use on horses intended for human consumption.

To protect horses from House Flies, Face Flies, Horn Flies, Stable Flies, Black Flies, Horse Flies, Deer Flies, Lice and Ticks, and from biting gnats such as Punkies and No-see-ums: thoroughly brush the horse's coat prior to application to remove loose dirt and debris. For dirty horses, shampoo and rinse thoroughly. Wait until coat is completely dry before applying CRASH! FLY SPRAY CONCENTRATE. Dilute at the rate of one (1) part CRASH! FLY SPRAY CONCENTRATE to three (3) parts water. For one quart of finished spray, pour eight (8) ounces of CRASH! FLY SPRAY CONCENTRATE into a one (1) quart spray container and fill with clean water. Always mix fresh solution before each use. CRASH! FLY SPRAY CONCENTRATE may be applied either as a spray or as a wipe. For maximum protection apply 2 to 4 ounces (60-120 ml) as a light spray or wipe over horse's entire body. Do not soak hair or skin. For horse's face, always apply as a wipe using a piece of clean, absorbent cloth (mitt), toweling (turkish) or sponge. Wear protective gloves when applying as a wipe. Avoid getting spray or wipe into horse's eyes, nose, or mouth. Repeat application as necessary and each time animal is washed, but no more often than once every 5 to 7 days.
