SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING.

Not for use on horses intended for human consumption.

To protect horses from House Flies, Face Flies, Horn Flies, Stable Flies, Black Flies, Horse Flies, Deer Flies, Lice and Ticks, and from biting gnats such as Punkies and No-see-ums: thoroughly brush the horse's coat prior to application to remove loose dirt and debris. For dirty horses, shampoo and rinse thoroughly. Wait until coat is completely dry before applying CRASH! FLY SPRAY CONCENTRATE. Dilute at the rate of one (1) part CRASH! FLY SPRAY CONCENTRATE to three (3) parts water. For one quart of finished spray, pour eight (8) ounces of CRASH! FLY SPRAY CONCENTRATE into a one (1) quart spray container and fill with clean water. Always mix fresh solution before each use. CRASH! FLY SPRAY CONCENTRATE may be applied either as a spray or as a wipe. For horse's face, always apply as a wipe using a piece of clean, absorbent cloth, toweling (Turkish) or sponge. As protection builds, reapply every 10 to 14 days as needed. Also, reapply each time the animal is washed or exposed to rain.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry place inaccessible to children and pets.
