To protect horses from House Flies, Face Flies, Horn Flies, Stable Flies, Black Flies, Horse Flies, Deer Flies, Lice and Ticks, and from biting gnats such as Punkies and No-see-ums: thoroughly brush the horse's coat prior to application to remove loose dirt and debris. For dirty horses, shampoo and rinse thoroughly. Wait until coat is completely dry before applying CRASH! FLY SPRAY CONCENTRATE. Dilute at the rate of one (1) part CRASH! FLY SPRAY CONCENTRATE to three (3) parts water. For one quart of finished spray, pour eight (8) ounces of CRASH! FLY SPRAY CONCENTRATE into a one (1) guart spray container and fill with clean water.
