The Agency in accordance with the Federal Fungicide and Rodenticide Act as Amended (FIFRA) has completed reviewing all of the information submitted with your application to support the reregistration of the aforementioned product in connection with the MGK<sup>®</sup> 326 RED, and have concluded that your submission is acceptable with the following label revision provisions:

1. Revise the marketing claims by deleting the statement "Contains a sunscreening agent for added protection and beneficial conditioners for the skin and coat."

The claim sunscreen is an implied safety claim (40 CFR 156.10). The coat conditioning claims concern the value of the product for purposes other than a pesticide (40 CFR 156.10).

2. Revise the **DIRECTIONS FOR USE** statement by deleting the following statement: "Application should be liberal for best results."

Also, add the following statement: "Do not apply more than 1 time per day."

Revise the "**Disposal**" statements within the **STORAGE AND DISPOSAL** statement as follows:

"Disposal: Do not reuse or refill this container. If Empty: Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. If Partly Filled: Call your local solid waste agency or 1-800-CLEANUP for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain."

The Agency is in the process of developing and improving the current Efficacy Assessment Guidelines. The Agency intends to defer the determination of any related efficacy data requirements supporting the claims that may appear on this label until these Efficacy Assessment Guidelines are complete. When the guidelines are finalized, the Agency expects to issue a Data Call-In to address the revised guidelines to all registrants with registrations for personal repellent products that have not previously submitted efficacy data sufficiently consistent with the revised guidelines.

NOTE: This product is not being re-registered under FIFRA Sec. 4(g) at this time.

Farnam Companies, Inc. should note that a notice of availability of EPA's reregistration eligibility decision (RED) document for products containing pyrethrins was published in the *Federal Register* on July 26, 2006 (Volume 71, Number 143, Pages 42387-42389). EPA's RED for products containing piperonyl butoxide was published in the *Federal Register* on July 26, 2006 (Volume 71, Number 143, Pages 42385-42386). In addition, EPA's RED for products containing cypermethrin was published in the *Federal Register* on March 19, 2008 (Volume 73, Number 54, Page 14793). As a result, additional data and/or labeling changes may be required for products containing pyrethrins, piperonyl butoxide, and/or cypermethrin.

You must submit two copies of the final printed label revised in accordance with the comments listed above before the product is released for shipment under this label. If you have any questions, you may contact Clayton Myers at (703) 347-8874 or <u>myers.clayton@epa.gov</u>.

To protect horses from House Flies, Face Flies, Horn Flies, Stable Flies, Black Flies, Horse Flies, Deer Flies, Lice and Ticks, and from biting gnats such as Punkies and No-see-ums: thoroughly brush the horse's coat prior to application to remove loose dirt and debris. For dirty horses, shampoo and rinse thoroughly. Wait until coat is completely dry before applying CRASH! FLY SPRAY CONCENTRATE. Dilute at the rate of one (1) part CRASH!
