ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish. Do not apply directly to water or to areas where surface water is present or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters or rinsate.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Do not use on horses or foals intended for slaughter. Do not apply over cuts, wounds, or irritated skin. Do not apply near eyes and mouth. Apply sparingly around ears. Wash hands with soap and water promptly after use.

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING.

To protect horses from House Flies, Face Flies, Horn Flies, Stable Flies, Black Flies, Horse Flies, Deer Flies, Lice and Ticks, and from biting gnats such as Punkies and No-see-ums: thoroughly brush the horse's coat prior to application to remove loose dirt and debris. For dirty horses, shampoo and rinse thoroughly. Wait until coat is completely dry before applying CRASH! FLY SPRAY CONCENTRATE. Dilute at the rate of one (1) part CRASH! FLY SPRAY CONCENTRATE to three (3) parts water. For one quart of finished spray, pour eight (8) ounces of CRASH! FLY SPRAY CONCENTRATE into a one (1) quart spray container and fill with clean water. Always mix fresh solution before each use. CRASH! FLY SPRAY CONCENTRATE may be applied either as a spray or as a wipe. For horse's face, always apply as a wipe using a piece of clean, absorbent cloth, toweling (Turkish) or sponge. Spray or wipe horse's entire body while brushing against the lay of the coat to ensure adequate coverage. Avoid getting spray into horse's eyes, nose or mouth. Wear protective gloves when applying as a wipe. Do not apply more than 1 time per day. Reapply every 5 to 7 days under normal conditions after initial application. As protection builds, reapply every 10 to 14 days as needed. Also, reapply each time the animal is washed or exposed to rain.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry place inaccessible to children and pets. Always store pesticides in the original container. If a leaky container must be contained within another, mark the outer container to identify the contents. Keep pesticide storage areas clean. Clean up any spills promptly. Store pesticides away from food, pet food, seed, fertilizers, and veterinary supplies.

DISPOSAL: Nonrefillable. Do not reuse or refill this container. **If Empty:** Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. **If Partly Filled:** Call your local solid waste agency for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.
