2. Have the following changes listed below before you release the product for sale:

a. Add the phrase "In Registration No. 270-251."

b. Delete the wording "Super Strength." Such wording is not allowed under FIFRA section 162.10(a)(5)(iv) and (vi). The same holds true for the word "Advanced" in "Advanced Formula." However, in this case you may use the word "New," but only for a period of 6 months.

c. Add the wording, "Wash hands with soap and water after use," to the "Precautionary Statements" section and "Directions for Use."

- d. Revise the "If Swallowed" statement to read, "Contact a Physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger or by administering syrup of ipecac. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person."

If you disagree with the above statement please submit your justification for not inducing vomiting.

- e. Under "Directions" add the statement "Wear rubber glove or mitt when applying as a wipe."
- f. Under "Horses" add: Harmful if swallowed. Avoid breathing spray mist. Avoid contamination of food.
- g. We suggest that you block with solid print the "Storage and Disposal" section.
- h. Please add a street address or P.O. Box to the company name/city/State.

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION

Directions For Use

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Not for use on horses intended for human consumption.

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING

To protect horses from Horse Flies, Stable Flies, Face Flies, Horn Flies, Deer Flies, Gnats, Mosquitoes, Lice and Ticks: thoroughly brush the horse's coat prior to application to remove loose dirt and debris. For dirty horses,

Shampoo and rinse thoroughly. Wait until coat is completely dry before applying CRASH FLY SPRAY.

CRASH FLY SPRAY may be applied either as a spray or as a wipe. For horse's face, always apply as a wipe using a piece of clean, absorbent cloth, toweling (Turkish) or sponge. Spray or wipe horse's entire body while brushing against the lay of the coat to insure adequate coverage. Avoid getting spray into horse's eyes, nose or mouth.

Application should be liberal for best residual results. Reapply every 5 to 7 days under normal conditions for initial application. As protection builds, reapply every 10 to 14 days as needed. Also, reapply each time animal is washed or exposed to heavy rain.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Store in a cool, dry place.

Pesticide Disposal: Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.

Container Disposal: Do not reuse empty can. Wrap can and put in trash.
