Subject: Amendment - Alternate Formulation/Removal of R-11 Repellent
Farnam Crash Fly Spray
EPA Registration No. 270-251
Your Applications Dated February 7, 1989 and May 1, 1990

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided that you make the labeling changes indicated below prior to release for shipment of product bearing the amended labeling.

1. Under the Environmental Hazards Statement revise the second and third sentence as follows:

Do not apply to any body of water. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwater.

Please provide the chemical identity of all components, CAS Numbers, percent of mixture, and the Health Effects of:

1. Silicone Emulsion
2. Anti-Foam AF-30-Ind 440

The supplier may contact us directly referencing your EPA Registration No. in their response. This information was previously requested but to date was has not been submitted.

The Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF) dated May 1, 1990 is the formula of record. All previous CSFs are obsolete. The alternate formulation request submitted February 7, 1989 is not acceptable since it contains R-11. To be acceptable you must remove the R-11 and provide the chemical identity, CAS Number, percent in the mixture, and any health effect information for Fragrance V-7120.

The EPA Registration No. 279-3013 does not represent cypermethrin. Please provide a correct Confidential Statement of Formula with the corrected EPA Registration Number for this active ingredient.

Submit five copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION

HUMANS: For animal use only, Not for use on humans. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contact with eyes, skin or clothing. Avoid breathing spray mist. Avoid contamination of food. Wash hands with soap and water after use.

HORSES: Avoid contact with eyes or mucous membranes. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid breathing spray mist. Avoid contamination of food.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED: Contact a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger or by administering syrup of ipecac. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. **IF INHALED:** Remove victim to fresh air. To protect horses from Horse Flies, House Flies, Stable Flies, Face Flies, Horn Flies Deer Flies,

Gnats, Mosquitoes, Lice and Ticks: thoroughly brush the horse's coat prior to application to remove loose dirt and debris. For dirty horses, shampoo and rinse thoroughly. Wait until coat is completely dry before applying CRASH FLY SPRAY.

CRASH may be applied either as a spray or as a wipe. For horse's face, always apply as a wipe using a piece of clean, absorbent cloth, toweling (Turkish) or sponge. Wear rubber glove or mitt when applying as a wipe. Spray or wipe horse's entire body while brushing against the lay of the coat to insure adequate coverage. Avoid getting spray into horse's eyes, nose or mouth.

Application should be liberal for best residual results. Reapply every 5 to 7 days under normal conditions for initial applications. As protection builds, reapply every 10 to 14 days as needed. Also, reapply each time animal is washed or exposed to heavy rain.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry place.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Securely wrap empty original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty can. Wrap can and put in trash.
