- c. Revise the Statement of Practical Treatment to read as follows:

IF ON SKIN: Wash with plenty of soap and water. Get medical attention.

IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth. Get medical attention.

IF IN EYES: Flush with plenty of water. Call a physician if irritation persists.

IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or Poison Control Center. Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

Thoroughly brush the horse's coat prior to application to remove loose dirt and debris. For best results shampoo and rinse, wait until coat is completely dry and apply **CRASH! WIPE-ON**. Using protective gloves or mitt, apply a light film of two to four ounces (60-120 ml) over horse's entire body, or spot treat areas of the horse where flies gather. May be applied around superficial wounds and abrasions. Avoid direct application to eyes, nose and mouth. Repeat application as necessary but no more often than once every 5 to 7 days. Wash hands with soap and water after use.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry place inaccessible to children and pets.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash.
