It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

DIP DEFINITION:

TO DIP: Place dog into dipping solution quickly and remove immediately. Do not submerge the dog's head under the solution or allow dog to remain in dipping solution for long periods of time.

FOR WATER SPRAY OR DIP: Mix 1/2 pint of dip with 8 gallons of water, or mix 1 ounce (2 tablespoons) of dip per gallon. Dip. Repeat treatment at weekly intervals for 2 or more applications as needed.

NOTE: All dogs must be treated thoroughly, including inside of ears. Two applications, a week apart, may be necessary. Infested premises should be sprayed using 1 pint of dip to 16 gallons of water; replace litter. Children under 13 should not be allowed to handle or apply this product. An individual applicator must not apply this product more than 12 times per year. Each treatment of three dogs or fewer should be considered one use. Applicators must wear long-sleeved shirt; long pants; elbow-length waterproof gloves; waterproof apron; and unlined, waterproof boots. Improper dilution could cause serious injury to your dog. For kennel, commercial, farm and sport dog used only.

"Used dip solutions must be disposed of in accordance with the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA). If the applicator generates more than 1000kg used dip solution in combination with other hazardous waste, the material must be treated as a hazardous waste subject to subpart C of RCRA. Any user who wishes to treat, store or dispose of hazardous waste must obtain a permit to serve as a hazardous waste facility pursuant to RCRA."

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

DO NOT STORE NEAR HEAT OR OPEN FLAME.

DO NOT INDUCE VOMITING: Vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia.
