Dear Ms. Purcell:

The amendment to update the First Aid Statement per PRN 2001-1, and to update the Disposal Section, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA section 3(c)(7)(A), is acceptable provided that you:

1. Submit and/or cite all data required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 3(c)(5) and section 4 when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data.
2. Submit three (3) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Final printed labeling means the label or labeling of the product when distributed or sold. Clearly legible reproductions or photo reductions will be accepted for unusual labels, such as those silk-screened directly onto glass or metal containers or large bags or drum labels.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.



ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish, birds and other wildlife. Do not apply directly to water or wetlands. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. Apply this product only as specified on the label.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Contents under pressure. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

TPC EQUI-SPRAY "N" WIPE has been especially developed for use on horses. It gives a protective hair coating against flies while imparting a high sheen to the hair when brushed out. 1-2 ounces per animal applied daily gives adequate protection. Apply product with a soft cloth or as a fine mist.

For maximum repellent effectiveness of this product, repeat applications at one hour intervals.

TO WIPE ON

Make sure horse's hair is free of dirt by brushing thoroughly before applying product. Moisten a soft cloth with TPC EQUI-SPRAY "N" WIPE and rub over the hair paying special attention to the legs, shanks, shoulders, neck and areas around the face where flies generally are seen. It is best to apply by rubbing against the hair growth. Avoid using an excessive amount of animals. Do not wet skin. Brushing thoroughly after application will help bring out a sheen on hair coat. Repeat application daily or as needed.

USE AS SPRAY

EQUI-SPRAY "N" WIPE may be applied as a fine mist spray in and around stable area and stabled horses. Do not wet horse's skin or use more than two ounces per application.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

**STORAGE:** Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Store in a cool, dry place inaccessible to children and pets. **DISPOSAL:** If empty: Do not reuse this container. Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. **If partly filled:** Call your local solid waste agency or call 1-800-CLEANUP for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.
