DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

HORSES: To control biting lice and sucking lice on horses, remove cap and dust directly to all parts of animal body. Brush well into hair. Pay particular attention to the neck, mane, tail, flanks and places where hair is long. Repeat application after two weeks if necessary. Apply to animals quarters and bedding to aid in prevention of reinfestation.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

Storage: Store in a cool dry place.

Pesticidal Disposal: Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of in site or at an approved waste disposal facility.
