Dear Ms. Chavez;

The Agency in accordance with the Federal Fungicide and Rodenticide Act as Amended (FIFRA) has completed reviewing all of the information submitted with your application to support the reregistration of the aforementioned product in connection with the MGK[®] 326 RED, and have concluded that your submission is acceptable with the following label revision provisions:

1. Add a "NET CONTENTS" statement on page 1, listed in units of fluid ounces.

The Agency is in the process of developing and improving the current Efficacy Assessment Guidelines. The Agency intends to defer the determination of any related efficacy data requirements supporting the claims that may appear on this label until these Efficacy Assessment Guidelines are complete. When the guidelines are finalized, the Agency expects to issue a Data Call-In to address the revised guidelines to all registrants with registrations for personal repellent products that have not previously submitted efficacy data sufficiently consistent with the revised guidelines.

NOTE: This product is not being re-registered under FIFRA Sec. 4(g) at this time.

Farnam Companies, Inc. should note that a notice of availability of EPA's reregistration eligibility decision (RED) document for products containing pyrethrins was published in the *Federal Register* on July 26, 2006 (Volume 71, Number 143, Pages 42387-42389). EPA's RED

for products containing piperonyl butoxide was published in the *Federal Register* on July 26, 2006 (Volume 71, Number 143, Pages 42385-42386). EPA's RED for products containing permethrin was published in the *Federal Register* on February 27, 2008 (Volume 73, Number 39, Pages 10433-10434). EPA's RED for products containing MGK[®] 264 was published in the *Federal Register* on July 26, 2006 (Volume 71, Number 143, Pages 42381-42383). As a result, additional data and/or labeling changes may be required for products containing pyrethrins, piperonyl butoxide, permethrin, and/or MGK[®] 264.

You must submit two copies of the final printed label revised in accordance with the comments listed above before the product is released for shipment under this label. If you have any questions, you may contact Clayton Myers at (703) 347-8874 or myers.clayton@epa.gov.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

FLAMMABLE. Keep away from heat and open flame. Contains alcohol. Do not apply to painted or finished wood surfaces.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish. Do not apply directly to water or to areas where surface water is present or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters or rinsate.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Do not use on horses or foals intended for slaughter. Do not apply over cuts, wounds, or irritated skin. Do not apply near eyes and mouth. Apply sparingly around ears.

For initial treatment, apply daily for 2-3 days. As infestation subsides, repeat treatment every 5-10 days or as prescribed by a veterinarian. Also re-apply every time animal is washed or exposed to heavy rain. Do not apply more than one time per day.

Consult a veterinarian before using this product on debilitated, aged, pregnant, nursing or medicated animals.

USE ONLY IN WELL VENTILATED AREA. HOLD BOTTLE IN UPRIGHT POSITION WHEN SPRAYING:

Dogs: Cover animal's eyes with hands. With a firm stroke to get a proper spray mist, spray head, ears and chest until damp. With fingertips, rub into face around mouth, nose and eyes. Then spray neck, middle and hind quarters, finishing legs last. For best penetration of spray to the skin, direct spray against the natural lay of the hair. On long-haired dogs, rub your hand against the lay of the hair, spraying the ruffled hair directly behind the hand. Make sure spray thoroughly wets ticks.

Horses: Thoroughly brush the horse's coat, prior to application, to remove loose dirt and debris. For dirty horses, and as a preparation for show grooming, clean the coat with a quality shampoo. Wait until coat is completely dry before applying. Cover entire surface of animal with spray but avoid getting product into horse's eyes or other sensitive areas such as mouth or nose. Brush coat against grain while spraying to insure adequate penetration of product. As a wipe, apply liberally with a clean cloth or sponge. Make sure spray has completely dried before covering with any tack.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in original container in a cool, dry place inaccessible to children and pets. If a leaky container must be contained within another, mark the outer container to identify the contents. Store pesticides away from food, pet food, seed, fertilizers, and veterinary supplies. **DISPOSAL:** Do not reuse or refill this container. **If empty:** Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. **If partly filled:** Call your local solid waste agency for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.
