USE TO WIPE ON: First brush the animal to remove excess dirt and dust. Moisten (but do not wet to point of dripping) soft cloth and rub over the hair. It is best to apply by rubbing against the hair growth. Give special attention to the legs, shoulders, shanks, neck and facial areas where flies most often are seen.
