The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below.

- 1) For the purpose of clarity and consistency with other labels, in accordance with P.R. Notice 2001-1, revise the First Aid statement to read as follows:

IF SWALLOWED:

- o Call poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice.
- o Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow.
- o Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by the poison control center or doctor.
- o Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

IF on SKIN or

CLOTHING:

- o Take off contaminated clothing.
- o Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes.
- o Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment.


- IF IN EYES:**
- o Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes.
 - o Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye.
 - o Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

- IF INHALED:**
- o Move person to fresh air.
 - o If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible.
 - o Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice.

2) Enclosed is a copy of your label stamped "Accepted With Comments". Submit four (4) copies of the final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

EQUISECT™ Fly Repellent is formulated using pyrethrum and a blend of botanical and essential oils – citronella, clove stem, thyme, and combrint. This water-based product is non-irritating, so it is gentle to your horse's skin and coat.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

DO NOT USE ON HORSES INTENDED FOR SLAUGHTER

HORSES AND PONIES: To repel and kill Horn Flies, Stable Flies, House Flies, Horse Flies, Deer Flies, Mosquitoes and Gnats, apply EQUISECT™ Fly Repellent as directed below.

As a Spray: Remove excess dirt and dust. Apply a light spray mist sufficient to wet the surface of the hair while brushing lightly against the lay of the hair. Avoid spraying in eyes and mucous membranes. Apply with a sponge or soft cloth to these areas.

As a Wipe-On: Thoroughly brush horse to remove dirt and dust. Extremely dirty horses should be shampooed, rinsed and allowed to dry before applying. Use a sponge or clean soft cloth.

Apply EQUISECT™ Fly Repellent liberally over areas to be protected. Pay special attention to legs, belly, shoulders, neck and facial areas. Avoid eyes and mucous membranes.

Repeat treatment daily or at intervals necessary to give continued protection.

To control blood-sucking lice apply EQUISECT™ Fly Repellent to the infested areas of the animal using a stiff brush to get the spray to the base of the hair. Repeat every 2 to 3 weeks if required.

DOGS AND CATS: To control fleas and ticks on dogs and cats, apply EQUISECT™ Fly Repellent starting at the animal's head (avoiding the eyes, nose and mouth as you spray). Make sure the entire body is covered, including the legs, underbody and tail. While spraying, fluff the hair so that the spray will penetrate to the skin. Make sure spray wets the animal thoroughly. Avoid contact with genitals. Repeat treatment daily. Do not use on dogs and cats under 12 weeks of age. Consult a veterinarian before using this product on debilitated, aged, pregnant, medicated or nursing animals.

Sensitivities may occur after using ANY pesticide products for pets. If signs of sensitivity occur bathe your pet with mild soap and rinse with large amounts of water. If signs continue, consult a veterinarian immediately.

PET AREAS: To control fleas and ticks in premises, thoroughly spray infested areas, pet beds, quarters, nearby cracks and crevices, along and behind baseboards, moldings, window and door frames with EQUISECT™ Fly Repellent. Fresh bedding should be placed in the animal's quarters following treatment. Repeat treatment as needed. Concurrent treatment of pets with a registered on animal product is recommended.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Do not transport or store under 32°F (0°C).

STORAGE: Store in original container in a cool dry place inaccessible to children and pets. Protect from freezing.

DISPOSAL: If Empty: Do not reuse this container. Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. If Partially Filled: Call your local solid waste agency or call 1-800-CLEANUP for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.
