ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to aquatic organisms, including fish and invertebrates. To protect the environment, do not allow pesticide to enter or run off into storm drains, drainage ditches, gutters or surface waters. Applying this product in calm weather when rain is not predicted for the next 24 hours will help to ensure that wind or rain does not blow or wash pesticide off the treatment area.

This product is highly toxic to bees exposed to direct treatment on blooming crops or weeds. Do not apply this product or allow it to drift to blooming crops or weeds while bees are actively visiting the treatment area.

Farnam Equine Fly Repellent 397 is formulated using pyrethrum and blend of (botanicals) and (essential)(citronella, clove stem, thyme and corn mint) oils. This water-based product is nonirritating, so it is gentle to both your horse's skin and coat.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Not for use in outdoor residential misting systems. Do not apply this product in a way that will contact children, either directly or through drift. Except when applying directly to horses, ponies, dogs and cats, do not apply this product in a way that will contact adults or pets, either directly or through drift.

DO NOT USE ON HORSES INTENDED FOR SLAUGHTER

HORSES AND PONIES: To [repel][protect horses and ponies from][kill] Horn Flies, Stable Flies, House Flies, Horse Flies, Deer Flies, Mosquitoes and Gnats, apply Farnam Equine Fly Repellent 397 as directed below.

AS A SPRAY: Remove excess dirt and dust. Apply a light spray mist sufficient to wet the surface of the hair while brushing lightly against the lay of the hair. Avoid spraying in eyes and mucous membranes. Apply with a sponge or soft cloth to these areas.

AS A WIPE-ON: Thoroughly brush horse to remove dirt and dust. Extremely dirty horses should be shampooed, rinsed and allowed to dry before applying. Use a sponge or clean soft cloth.

Apply Farnam Equine Fly Repellent 397 to point before run off over areas to be protected. Pay special attention to legs, belly, shoulders, neck and facial areas. Avoid eyes and mucous membranes.

Repeat treatment daily or at intervals necessary to give continued protection.

(To control blood-sucking lice**, apply Farnam Equine Fly Repellent 397 to the infested areas of the animal, using a stiff brush to get the spray to the base of the hair. Repeat every 2 to 3 weeks if required.)

DOGS AND CATS

To control fleas and ticks on dogs and cats, apply Farnam Equine Fly Repellent 397 starting at the animal's head (avoiding the eyes, nose and mouth as you spray). Make sure the entire body is covered, including the legs, underbody and tail. While spraying, fluff the hair so that the spray will penetrate to the skin. Make sure spray wets the animal thoroughly. Avoid contact with genitalia. Repeat treatment daily. Do not use on dogs and cats under 12 weeks of age. Consult a veterinarian before using this product on debilitated, aged, pregnant, medicated or nursing animals.

Sensitivities may occur after using ANY pesticide product for pets. If signs of sensitivity occur, bathe your pet with mild soap and rinse with large amounts of water. If signs continue, consult a veterinarian immediately.

PET AREAS

To control fleas and ticks in premises, thoroughly spray infested areas, pet beds, quarters, nearby cracks and crevices, along and behind baseboards moldings, window and door frames with Farnam Equine Fly Repellent 397. Do not wet articles to point of runoff or drip. Do not use treated article until spray has dried. Fresh bedding should be placed in the animal's quarters following treatment. Repeat treatment as needed. Concurrent treatment of pets with another registered (Farnam) (on animal product(s)) (dip) (shampoo) (flea collar) is recommended. Remove or cover exposed food and drinking water before application. Remove or cover dishes, utensils, food processing equipment, and food preparation surfaces, or wash them before use. Do not remain in treated area. Exit area immediately and remain outside the treated area until vapors and/or mists have dispersed. Not for use in outdoor residential misting systems.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Store in a cool, dry place inaccessible to children and pets.

DISPOSAL: Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill container. If empty: Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. If partly filled: Call your local solid waste agency for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.
