The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. One copy of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment.

Revise the claim that precedes the ingredient statement to delete the reference to animals, so that it read as follows:

Farnam X-5306-98 contains two insecticide systems and two repellents for use on horses...

In the directions for use in stables and barns, measures of liquid must be expressed in US customary units as fluid ounces, not ounces.

Verify that 6.4 fluid ounces makes one gallon of spray, and adjust if appropriate.

Add to the directions for spraying in stables and barns the following: Do not contaminate water, food or feed. If you have questions, please call Ann Sibold at 703 305-6502.

#### **DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

#### SHAKE WELL BEFORE USE

HORSES: Thoroughly brush horse's coat prior to application to remove loose dirt and debris. For dirty horses, and as a preparation for show grooming, clean the coat with a shampoo. Use at a 1 to 4 ratio with water. Put required amount of concentrate into sprayer or mixing container and add appropriate amount of water (1 pint of concentrate makes 5 pints of spray). Cover entire surface of animal with spray, but avoid getting product into horse's eyes, or other sensitive areas such as mouth or nose. Spray horse's coat especially around shoulders, flanks, neck and legs. Brush coat against grain while spraying to insure adequate penetration of product. Make sure application has completely dried on hair coat before covering with tack. As a wipe, apply liberally with a clean cloth or sponge. For initial treatment, apply daily. As infestation subsides and protection builds, reapply every 2-3 days as needed. Also, reapply every time animal is washed or exposed to a heavy rain. Do not use on horses or foals intended for slaughter.

FOR STABLES AND BARNS: Use at a 1 to 19 ratio with water. Put required amount of concentrate into sprayer or mixing container and add appropriate amount of water (6.4 ounces of concentrate make on gallon of spray.) To apply as a space spray, use a hand sprayer or mechanical spray equipment (non-thermal). Set spray nozzles to deliver a fine mist. Direct spray to distribute evenly throughout the entire area at a rate or one ounce per 1000 cubic feet of space. Do not use in milk rooms. For space spraying, do not remain in treated areas and ventilate before reoccupying. Animals should be removed from area prior to treatment.

# PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS: CAUTION

HUMANS: Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid contact with eyes or clothing. Wash hands before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco or using the toilet.

ANIMALS: Avoid contact with eyes, or mucous membranes. Avoid treatment of foals

under 6 weeks of age unless prescribed by a veterinarian.
