Dear Ms. Chavez;

The Agency in accordance with the Federal Fungicide and Rodenticide Act as Amended (FIFRA) has completed reviewing all of the information submitted with your application to support the reregistration of the aforementioned product in connection with the MGK<sup>®</sup> 326 RED, and have concluded that your submission is acceptable.

The Agency is in the process of developing and improving the current Efficacy Assessment Guidelines. The Agency intends to defer the determination of any related efficacy data requirements supporting the claims that may appear on this label until these Efficacy Assessment Guidelines are complete. When the guidelines are finalized, the Agency expects to issue a Data Call-In to address the revised guidelines to all registrants with registrations for products that have not previously submitted efficacy data sufficiently consistent with the revised guidelines.

NOTE: This product is not being re-registered under FIFRA Sec. 4(g) at this time.

Farnam Companies, Inc. should note that a notice of availability of EPA's reregistration eligibility decision (RED) document for products containing piperonyl butoxide was published in the *Federal Register* on July 26, 2006 (Volume 71, Number 143, Pages 42385-42386). The notice for EPA's RED for butoxypolypropylene glycol was published in the *Federal Register* on December 21, 2007 (Volume 72, Number 245 Page 72713-72715). As a result, additional data and/or labeling changes may be required for products containing piperonyl butoxide and

butoxypolypropylene glycol.

A copy of your label stamped "Accepted" is enclosed for your records.



#### ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish. Do not apply directly to water or to areas where surface water is present or to intertidal areas below the man high water mark. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters or rinsate.

#### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Do not use on horses or foals intended for slaughter. Do not apply over cuts, wounds, or irritated skin. Do not apply near eyes and mouth. Apply speringly around ears.

#### SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING

Before applying FARNAM X-5369-99 to your horse, brush him down thoroughly to remove loose dust and dirt. Moisten, but do not soak, a folded piece of Turkish toweling (approximately 12" x 15") or an Applicator Mitt with FARNAM X-5369-99. Rub briskly against the growth direction of hair. Give special attention to shanks, legs, shoulders, neck and facial areas of the horse where flies tend to cause the greatest problems. Add more FARNAM X-5369-99 to the applicator as needed, applying approximately one to two fluid ounces for the total application on a daily basis (the variance will depend on the size of the horse). Groom with a brush.

To kill attached ticks, dab FARNAM X-5369-99 directly on the tick with a saturated cloth.

For use with Farnam Repellent Strips: Saturate strips with FARNAM X-5369-99, allowing excess FARNAM X-5369-99 to drain from strip prior to use. See Farnam Repellent Strip label for proper attachment to horse.

#### A FEW IMPORTANT POINTS TO REMEMBER:

- To keep the applicator moist, keep in an airtight container between uses.
- Daily applications of FARNAM X-5369-99 may build up repellency allowing a reduction in the amount used in subsequent applications.
- Apply in early morning for maximum efficacy.
- The amount of FARNAM X-5369-99 needed depends on temperature, humidity, and cleanliness of the horse's coat

#### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

**Pesticide Storage:** Store in original container in a cool, dry place, inaccessible to children and pets. If a leaky container must be contained within another, mark the outer container to identify the contents. Do not store near heat or open flame. Store pesticides away from food, pet food, seed, fertilizers, and veterinary supplies.

Pesticide Disposal: Nonrefillable. Do not reuse or refill this container. If Empty: Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. If Partly Filled: Call your local solid waste agency for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.
