The Agency, in accordance with the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, has completed reviewing all the information submitted with your application to support the Registration Review of the above referenced product in connection with the Permethrin and Prallethrin Interim Decisions and has concluded that your submission is acceptable. The label referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA, as amended, is acceptable.

Should you wish to add/retain a reference to the company's website on your label, then please be aware that the website becomes labeling under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act and is subject to review by the Agency. If the website is false or misleading, the product would be misbranded and unlawful to sell or distribute under FIFRA section 12(a)(1)(E). 40 CFR 156.10(a)(5) list examples of statements EPA may consider false or misleading. For initial treatment, apply daily for 2-3 days. [After initial application, retreatment would be appropriate one to two times weekly.] [Retreat every 3 –5 days after initial treatment.] Also reapply every time animal is washed or exposed to heavy rain.

Horses, Ponies and Foals: Thoroughly brush the horse's coat prior to application, to remove loose dirt and debris. For dirty horses, and as a preparation for show grooming, clean the coat with a shampoo. Wait until coat is completely dry before applying spray. Cover entire surface of animal with spray but avoid getting product into horse's eyes or other sensitive areas such as mouth or nose. Brush coat against grain while spraying to insure adequate penetration of product. As a wipe, apply with a clean cloth or sponge. Make sure spray has completely dried before covering with any tack. Do not use on horses or foals intended for slaughter.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

Pesticide Storage: Store in a cool, dry (preferably locked) area that is inaccessible to children and pets and away from heat, sparks, or open flames. If a leaky container must be contained within another, mark the outer container to identify the contents. Do not store near heat or open flame. Store pesticides away from food, pet food, seed, fertilizers, and veterinary supplies.

Pesticide Disposal: Wastes resulting from use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.
