Dear Ms. Sisson:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. Two (2) copies of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

1. Replace "Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling" with "Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, or using tobacco." in the Precautionary Statements.

We have reviewed the two confidential statement of formulas dated September 23, 2003 and find them acceptable. These two CSF's will be designated the "basic" formulations. All other CSF's are considered obsolete. The confidential statement of formula has been inserted in the file for the subject product.

Remove product tube(s) from child resistant package. Holding tube with narrow end pointing up and away from face and body, cut off narrow end of tube with scissors or snap off narrow end at notches. Apply one tube (10.0 mL) of product solution as follows:

- 1] 5 mL along the back line starting at the top of head behind the ears, along the base of the mane, down the dorsal midline to the base of the tail.
- 2] 1 mL to the top of the forehead under the forelock.
- 3] 1 mL as a stripe to the front of each foreleg, from the ankle to the knee.
- 4] 1 mL as a stripe to the front of each hindleg, from the ankle to the hock.

Do not use more often than once every two weeks.
