Dear Ms. Chavez;

The Agency in accordance with the Federal Fungicide and Rodenticide Act as Amended (FIFRA) has completed reviewing all of the information submitted with your application to support the reregistration of the aforementioned product in connection with the MGK<sup>®</sup> 326 RED, and have concluded that your submission is acceptable with the following label revision provisions:

1. Delete the marketing statement "[Sold Only Through Licensed Veterinarians]". This statement is unenforceable.

The Agency is in the process of developing and improving the current Efficacy Assessment Guidelines. The Agency intends to defer the determination of any related efficacy data requirements supporting the claims that may appear on this label until these Efficacy Assessment Guidelines are complete. When the guidelines are finalized, the Agency expects to issue a Data Call-In to address the revised guidelines to all registrants with registrations for products that have not previously submitted efficacy data sufficiently consistent with the revised guidelines.

NOTE: This product is not being re-registered under FIFRA Sec. 4(g) at this time.

Farnam Companies, Inc. should note that a notice of availability of EPA's reregistration eligibility decision (RED) document for products containing piperonyl butoxide was published in

the *Federal Register* on July 26, 2006 (Volume 71, Number 143, Pages 42385-42386). EPA's RED for products containing pyrethrins was published in the *Federal Register* on July 26, 2006 (Volume 71, Number 143, Pages 42387-42389). EPA's RED for products containing MGK<sup>®</sup> 264 was published in the *Federal Register* on July 26, 2006 (Volume 71, Number 143, Pages 42381-42383). As a result, additional data and/or labeling changes may be required for products containing piperonyl butoxide, pyrethrins, and/or MGK<sup>®</sup> 264.

You must submit two copies of the final printed label revised in accordance with the comments listed above before the product is released for shipment under this label. # ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish. Do not add directly to water or to areas where surface water is present or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters or rinsate.

#### PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

FLAMMABLE. Keep away from heat and open flame. Contains alcohol. Do not apply to painted or finished wood surfaces.

#### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Do not apply over cuts, wounds or irritated skin. Do not apply near eyes and mouth. USE ONLY IN A WELL VENTILATED AREA. For indoor use only.

#### DOGS AND CATS

Cover animal's eyes with hand and with a firm, fast stroke to get a proper spray mist, spray head, ears and chest until damp. With fingertips, rub into face around mouth, nose and eyes. Then spray neck, middle and hindquarters, finishing legs last. For best penetration of spray to the skin, direct spray against the natural lay of the hair. On long haired dogs, rub your hand against the lay of hair, spraying the ruffled hair directly behind the hand. Make sure spray thoroughly wets ticks. Repeat every 9 days.

# PET'S INDOOR SLEEPING QUARTERS

For use in companion animal quarters only, do not broadcast outdoors. Remove animals from quarters before treating premises. Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by use of this product. Do not allow animals to return to quarters until treated areas have dried. Remove birds and cover or remove aquariums before spraying. Spray around baseboards, windows, doorframes, wall cracks and local area of floors. If mosquitoes, gnats or flies are present, spray lightly into air. Repeat every 9 days. The pet's bedding should be sprayed, making sure the area beneath the bedding is also sprayed. After spray has dried, remove old bedding and replace with fresh bedding. Treat pets with one of our registered flea and tick control products before allowing them to enter treated area.

HORSES

CAUTION: Do not use on horses or foals intended for slaughter. Do not apply over cuts, wounds, or irritated skin. Do not apply near eyes and mouth. Apply sparingly around ears.

To control stable flies, horse flies, deer flies and face flies, apply to face, legs, flanks, top line and other body areas commonly attacked by these flies. Repeat every 9 days.

## STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

**Pesticide Storage:** Store in original container in a cool, dry place, inaccessible to children and pets. If a leaky container must be contained within another, mark the outer container to identify the contents. Do not store near heat or open flame. Store pesticides away from food, pet food, seed, fertilizers, and veterinary supplies.

Pesticide Disposal: Nonrefillable. Do not reuse or refill this container. If Empty: Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. If Partly Filled: Call your local solid waste agency for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.
