Dear Ms. Chavez;

The Agency in accordance with the Federal Fungicide and Rodenticide Act as Amended (FIFRA) has completed reviewing all of the information submitted with your application to support the reregistration of the aforementioned product in connection with the MGK[®] 326 RED, and have concluded that your submission is acceptable with the following label revision provisions:

- 1. Delete the marketing claim sub-statement ", AND SUNSCREEN"¹
- 2. Revise the **FIRST AID** statements by placing them in the following order:
 - 1. "IF INHALED: . . ."
 - 2. "IF IN EYES: "
 - 3. "IF SWALLOWED:...."
 - 4. "IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING:"
- 3. Revise the HAZARD TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS statement as follows:

"CAUTION

Harmful if inhaled. Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid contact with eyes or clothing. Avoid breathing vapor. Prolonged or frequently repeated skin contact may cause allergic reactions in some individuals. Wear long-sleeved shirt, long pants, shoes, and socks."

The 'ANIMALS' statement may be retained as is.

4. Revise the **ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS** statement as follows:

"This pesticide is toxic to fish. Do not apply directly to water, or to areas where surface water is present or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters or rinsate."

5. Revise the **DIRECTIONS FOR USE** statement as follows:

Revise the text "Not for use on horses intended for slaughter" to read "Do not use on horses or foals intended for slaughter."

Also, revise the text "Note: Do not put directly on broken skin or an open wound" to read "Do not apply over cuts, wounds, or irritated skin."

Also, add the following text: "Do not apply near eyes and mouth. Apply sparingly around ears. Do not apply more than one (1) time per day."

Also, revise the "To Kill Ear Mites:" sub-statement in lines 1-4 as follows: "Place a small amount of Pet-Mite Lotion into each ear, applying only enough lotion to coat the surface of the ear canal. Gently massage the base of the ear. Leave lotion in ear for a few minutes and carefully wipe the excess lotion from the ear with cotton. Repeat once more once more after 7 days."

(This revision is necessary so as not to contradict the 'apply sparingly around ears statement' required by the MGK® 326 RED.)

6. Revise the **STORAGE AND DISPOSAL** statement as follows:

"STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage and disposal.

Storage: Store in a cool, dry place inaccessible to children and pets. Always store pesticides in the original container. If a leaky container must be contained within another, mark the outer container to identify the contents. Store pesticides away from food, pet food, seed, fertilizers, and veterinary supplies.

Disposal: Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. If Empty: Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. If partly filled: call your local solid waste

agency disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain."

The Agency is in the process of developing and improving the current Efficacy Assessment Guidelines. The Agency intends to defer the determination of any related efficacy data requirements supporting the claims that may appear on this label until these Efficacy Assessment Guidelines are complete. When the guidelines are finalized, the Agency expects to issue a Data Call-In to address the revised guidelines to all registrants with registrations for products that have not previously submitted efficacy data sufficiently consistent with the revised guidelines.

NOTE: This product is not being re-registered under FIFRA Sec. 4(g) at this time.

Farnam Companies, Inc. should note that a notice of availability of EPA's reregistration eligibility decision (RED) document for products containing piperonyl butoxide was published in the *Federal Register* on July 26, 2006 (Volume 71, Number 143, Pages 42385-42386). EPA's RED for products containing pyrethrins was published in the *Federal Register* on July 26, 2006 (Volume 71, Number 143, Pages 42387-42389). EPA's RED for products containing MGK[®] 264 was published in the *Federal Register* on July 26, 2006 (Volume 71, Number 143, Pages 42381-42383). As a result, additional data and/or labeling changes may be required for products containing piperonyl butoxide, pyrethrins, and/or MGK[®] 264.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

To Kill Ear Mites: Clean ear with Pet-Otic®. Place a sufficient amount of Pet-Mite Lotion into each ear to thoroughly coat the surface of the ear canal. Gently massage the base of the ear. Leave lotion in ear for a few minutes and carefully wipe the excess lotion from the ear with cotton. Do not reapply for 7 days. Lotion to be applied twice at 7 day intervals.

Consult a veterinarian before using this product on debilitated, aged, pregnant or nursing animals, or animals on medication. Do not use on puppies and kittens under 12 weeks.

INDICATIONS

FOR USE ON HORSES – Not for use on horses intended for slaughter. Controls flies, gnats, mites, mosquitoes, chiggers, lice and ticks. Before application, remove dirt or debris by brushing or washing with a mild detergent. When areas are completely dry, apply a light film to affected areas, massaging into the skin daily for 2 to 3 days. Then apply every 3 to 5 days as needed. To kill ticks, cover the tick with the lotion and let stand a few minutes before removing tick.

NOTE: Do not put directly on broken skin or an open wound.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry area away from heat and open flame. Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Do not transfer contents to other containers.

DISPOSAL: If empty: Do not reuse this container. Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. If partly filled: Call your local solid waste agency or 1-800-CLEANUP for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.
