The Agency, in accordance with the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, has completed reviewing all of the information submitted with your application to support the reregistration of the above referenced product in connection with the pyrethrin, pbo, and mgk 264 RED(s), and has concluded that your submission is acceptable.

NOTE: This product is not being reregistered under sections 3(c)5 and 4(g) of FIFRA at this time.

Please be reminded that 40 CFR Part 156.140(a)(4) requires that a batch code, lot number, or other code identifying the batch of the pesticide distributed and sold be placed on non-refillable containers. The code may appear either on the label or durably marked on the container itself, and can be added by non-notification per PRN 98-10.

Please note that, should you wish to add/retain a reference to the company's website on your label, the website becomes labeling under FIFRA and is subject to review by the Agency. If the website is false or misleading, the product would be misbranded and unlawful to sell or distribute under section 12(a)(1)(E) of FIFRA. 40 CFR §156.10(a)(5) lists examples of statements EPA may consider false or misleading. In addition, regardless of whether a website is referenced on your product's label, claims made on the website may not be substantially differ from those claims approved through the registration process. Therefore, should the Agency find, or if it is brought to our attention that a website contains false or misleading statements or claims substantially differing from the EPA-approved registration, the website will be referred to EPA's Office of Enforcement and Compliance Assurance (OECA). As an alternative, you may refer consumers to the company's phone number or e-mail address.

A copy of your label stamped "Accepted" is enclosed for the subject product. Products shipped after 12 months from the date of this amendment or the next printing of the label whichever occurs first, must bear the new revised label. Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended label constitutes acceptance of these conditions. If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e).

User should wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco, or using the toilet. User should remove clothing immediately if pesticides get inside. Then wash thoroughly and put on clean clothing. User should remove personal protective equipment immediately after handling this product. Wash the outside of gloves before removing. As soon as possible, wash thoroughly and change into clean clothing.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide is toxic to aquatic organisms, including fish and invertebrates. Do not apply directly to water, or to areas where surface water is present or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters or rinsate.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Do not apply over cuts, wounds, or irritated skin. Do not apply near eyes and mouth. Apply sparingly around ears. Wash hands with soap and water promptly after use.

SHAKE WELL BEFORE EACH USE

DOGS AND CATS: To kill fleas, ticks and lice, thoroughly mix a half-ounce (1 tablespoon) of ADAMS PYRETHRIN DIP with 1 gallon of warm water. Make fresh solution daily. If animal's coat is very dirty, bathe first with an ADAMS shampoo. Dip should be applied to dry or damp (not wet) coat. Sponge or dip animal with diluted ADAMS PYRETHRIN DIP making sure all areas are soaked to the skin. Let dip dry on animal. Do not use more than one gallon of diluted ADAMS PYRETHRIN DIP per animal. DO NOT RINSE OFF! Repeat treatment every 7 days if necessary.

HORSES: Dilute and thoroughly mix a half ounce (1 tablespoon) of ADAMS PYRETHRIN DIP with 1 gallon of warm water and apply as directed for dogs and cats. Do not use on horses or foals intended for slaughter. Do not use more than one gallon of diluted ADAMS PYRETHRIN DIP and do not apply more than 1 time per day.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. **Pesticide Storage:** Do Not store near heat or open flame.
