Dear Ms. Chavez;

The Agency in accordance with the Federal Fungicide and Rodenticide Act as Amended (FIFRA) has completed reviewing all of the information submitted with your application to support the reregistration of the aforementioned product in connection with the MGK[®] 326 RED, and have concluded that your submission is acceptable with the following label revision provisions:

1. Revise the signal word from "WARNING" to "CAUTION"

The Agency is in the process of developing and improving the current Efficacy Assessment Guidelines. The Agency intends to defer the determination of any related efficacy data requirements supporting the claims that may appear on this label until these Efficacy Assessment Guidelines are complete. When the guidelines are finalized, the Agency expects to issue a Data Call-In to address the revised guidelines to all registrants with registrations for personal repellent products that have not previously submitted efficacy data sufficiently consistent with the revised guidelines.

NOTE: This product is not being re-registered under FIFRA Sec. 4(g) at this time.



PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

FLAMMABLE. Keep away from heat and open flame. Contains alcohol. Do not apply to painted or finished wood surfaces.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. For indoor use only. Do not use on horses or foals intended for slaughter. Do not apply over cuts, wounds, or irritated skin. Do not apply near eyes and mouth, apply sparingly around ears. Do not apply more than one (1) time per day.

DOGS AND CATS

Remove safety cap and insert sprayer. Cover animal's eyes with hand and with a firm, fast stroke to get a proper spray mist, spray head, ears and chest until damp. With fingertips, rub into face around mouth, nose and eyes. Then spray neck, middle and hindquarters, finishing legs last. For best penetration of spray to the skin, direct spray against the natural lay of the hair. On long haired dogs, rub your hand against the lay of the hair, spraying the ruffled hair directly behind the hand. Make sure spray thoroughly wets ticks. Reapply every 14 days.

PET'S INDOOR SLEEPING QUARTERS

Spray around baseboards, windows, door frames, wall cracks and local area of floors. If mosquitoes, gnats, or flies are present, spray lightly into the air. Repeat as needed. The pet's bedding should be sprayed making sure the area beneath the bedding is also sprayed. After spray has dried, remove old bedding and replace with fresh bedding. Treat pets with one of our registered flea and tick control products before allowing them to enter treated area. For use in indoor companion animal quarters only, do not broadcast outdoors. Remove animals from quarters before treating premise. Do not allow animals to re-enter quarters until treated areas have dried. Do not contaminate water, food, or feed through use of this product.

HORSES

To control stable flies, horse flies, deer flies and face flies, apply to face, legs, flanks, top line and other body areas commonly attacked by these flies. Reapply every 14 days. Do not use on horses intended for food.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Store in original container in a cool, dry place inaccessible to children and pets. If a leaky container must be contained within another, mark the outer container to identify the contents. Store pesticides away from food, pet food, seed, fertilizers, and veterinary supplies. Do not store near heat or open flame.

Disposal: Nonrefillable. Do not reuse or refill this container. **If Empty:** Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. **If Partly Filled:** Call your local solid waste agency for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.
