

**NET WEIGHT**:

Active Ingredient ..... 100% Warfarin [3-(alpha-acetonylbenzyl)-4-hydroxycoumarin] Poisonous Solid, N.O.S.



ANTIDOTE: Give a tablespoon of salt in a glass of warm water and repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Call a Physician Immediately!

DANGER: Handle Warfarin with care. Avoid breathing dust; wear dust mask. Wash thoroughly after handling. Keep away from food products. Keep away from humans, domestic animals, wildlife or pets. If swallowed by humans, domestic animals, wildlife or pets, this material may reduce the clotting ability of the blood and cause bleeding. In such case, intravenous and oral administration of Vitamin K combined with blood tranfusions are indicated as in the case of hemorrhage caused by overdoses of bishydroxycourmarin.

Do not reuse empty container. Destroy it by perforating or crushing. Bury or discard in a safe place.
