Irrigation ditches, roadside ditches, flood water, standing ponds, woodland pools, snow melt pools, pastures, catchbasins, storm water retention areas, tidal water, salt marshes and rice fields.

Suggested Range Rate

2.5 - 10 lbs/acre

In addition, standing water containing mosquito larvae, in fields growing alfalfa, almonds, asparagus, corn, cotton, dates, grapes, peaches and walnuts may be treated at the recommended rates.

*Use 10-20 lbs./acre when late 3rd and early 4th instar larvae predominate, mosquito populations high, water is heavily polluted, (sewage lagoons, animal waste lagoons), and/or algae are abundant.

Apply uniformly by aerial or ground conventional equipment.

A 7 to 14 day interval between applications should be employed.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate potable water, food or feed by storage or disposal.
