On the basis of information furnished by the registrant, the above named pesticide is hereby registered/reregistered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act.

  - b. Change the Hazards to Humans statements to read as follows: "Corrosive. Causes irreversible eye damage. Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through the skin. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Avoid breathing dust. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse. Manufacturing operators must at a minimum wear a dust mask when handling this product."
  - c. Move your Statement of Practical treatment to the front panel and modify it so that it reads: "If in Eyes: Hold eyelids open and flush with a gentle stream of water for 15 minutes. Call a physician. / If Swallowed: Drink a large quantity milk, egg whites, gelatin solution, or if these are not available, drink large quantities of

3. Submit acceptable trout and Daphnia studies if the current studies on this active ingredient are found supplementary or invalid.

4. Submit two copies of the revised final printed label for the record.
