3. Verify that the levels of Verrucarin A and Roridin A are kept below a combined total of 15 ppm with the agreement that if any production batch approaches a total mycotoxin level of 10 - 15 ppm, a rationale as to why the mycotoxin levels have escalated must be submitted to the Agency and the registrant must reevaluate the manufacturing process.
 4. Submit five copies of the revised final printed label for the record.

Unconditional registration does not eliminate the need for continual reassessment of a pesticide. If EPA determines, at any time, that additional data are required to maintain in effect an existing registration, the Agency will require submission of such data under Section 3(c)(2)(B) of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA).


