- 4. Also, prior to the April 1, 2001 expiration date of this conditional registration, the submitted analytical enforcement method must be validated by an EPA laboratory.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Do not apply this product in a way that will contact workers or other persons, either directly or through drift. Only protected handlers may be in the area during application. 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AGRICULTURAL USE REQUIREMENTS

Use this product only in accordance with its labeling and with the Worker Protection Standard, 40 CFR part 170. This Standard contains requirements for the protection of agricultural workers on farms, forests, nurseries, and greenhouses, and handlers of agricultural pesticides. It contains requirements for training, decontamination, notification, and emergency assistance. It also contains specific instructions and exceptions pertaining to the statements on this label about personal protective equipment (PPE), and restricted-entry interval. GENERAL

NOTE: [S]-trans-2-Amino-4-(2-aminoethoxy)-3-butenoic acid hydrochloride is an extremely potent plant growth regulator. For best results, read all directions for use thoroughly. Consult your local Abbott agricultural specialist for the spray schedule best suited to your conditions. (1-800-323-9597)

Use only as directed. The label should be read thoroughly and understood before making applications. Product efficacy requires that all parts of the plant or crop receive uniform spray coverage or else the desired result may not occur. Consult your local Abbott agricultural

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specialist (1-800-323-9597) for specific information on the best rates, timings, and spray volumes for your region.

ReTainTM, which contains 15% [S]-trans-2-amino-4-(2-aminoethoxy)-3-butenoic acid hydrochloride, has been shown to be an effective preharvest drop control agent for apples and pears when applied 4 weeks prior to anticipated harvest. ReTainTM may also delay ripening and help maintain fruit quality (e.g., firmness). With apples, ReTainTM may reduce the incidence and/or severity of watercore and superficial scald. The active ingredient in ReTainTM is a fermentation metabolite that inhibits the endogenous production of ethylene in treated plant tissues.

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

Do not apply this product through any type of irrigation system. ReTainTM is to be applied only after fruit set has occurred. Use 333 grams (0.73 lb) of ReTainTM per acre 4 weeks prior to anticipated harvest. Apply ReTainTM in sufficient gallonage to ensure thorough, but not excessive, coverage. Use calibrated spray equipment to ensure uniform coverage of leaves and fruit. A nonionic wetting agent may improve spray coverage and enhance absorption.

Discard any unused spray material at the end of each day. Prepare solution concentrations by mixing the required amount of product with water in a clean, empty spray tank.

Special Considerations

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Apply early in the morning or late in the afternoon when drying conditions are slower in order to ensure adequate absorption. Limited information is available about tank mixing ReTainTM with late-season agrochemical products (i.e., insecticide or fungicide "cover sprays") registered for use on apples and/or pears. If tank mixing ReTainTM with a "cover spray" is absolutely necessary, consult your local Abbott agricultural specialist prior to making the application. (1-800-323-9597)
