

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE
RESTAURANTS, TAVERNS,
FOUNTAINS, ETC.**

First wash glasses, dishes, utensils and cooking equipment in a detergent cleaning solution which does not contain soap. Preferably rinse first with clear water, then rinse again for not less than 30 seconds in a sanitizing solution containing 2 ounces of Quaternary Ammonium Germicide to each 4 gallons of water. Rinse in potable water. Always allow sanitized equipment to air dry. Do not towel.

**AVOID CONTAMINATION OF FOOD.
SICKROOMS**

Use 1 ounce of Quaternary Ammonium Germicide in 1 gallon of water, spray the air several times a day in the sickroom. This will keep the air smelling fresh. Treat patient's dishes as directed under "Restaurants" and bed linen as directed below. Trays, bedpans, etc., should be sanitized with 1 ounce of Quaternary Ammonium Germicide in 1 gallon of water for five minutes after they have been thoroughly cleaned and rinsed.

**BARBER AND BEAUTY SHOP
EQUIPMENT**

Clean combs, brushes, etc., with a suitable detergent solution then soak for several minutes in a solution of 1 ounce of Quaternary Ammonium Germicide to ½ gallon of water. Towels should be treated as above.

Surfaces to be sanitized should first be thoroughly cleaned with a soapless cleaner. Then use 2 ounces of Quaternary Ammonium Germicide to 1 gallon of water as a spray or rinse for all working surfaces as well as walls, etc., to control bacteria and mold growth. Work tables, meat blocks and other places with which food may come in contact should be rinsed with clear water after sanitizing.

LINENS, DIAPERS: Wash clean and thoroughly rinse in clear water, then as a final rinse use 1 ounce in 4 gallons water. The sanitizing agent will remain in the cloth after drying and will aid in inhibiting formation of ammonia from bacteria which is one cause of diaper rash.

**DEODORIZING REFUSE
CONTAINERS, LOCKER ROOMS,
DAMP BASEMENTS, ETC.**

Use 2 ounces of Quaternary Ammonium Germicide in ½ gallon of water and spray over garbage and around toilet rooms, etc. This will destroy objectionable odors without leaving a “Disinfectant” smell behind.

CAUTION: HARMFUL IF SWALLOWED!
Avoid contact with eyes or skin. In case of contact, flush thoroughly with plenty of water. If eye irritation persists, get medical attention. Avoid contamination of food.
