

HOW TO ESTIMATE GALLON CAPACITY OF YOUR POOL

Measure Length (L), Width (W), and average Depth (D) in feet

For Square or Rectangular Pools:

$L \times W \times D \times 7.5 =$ Gallons

For Circular or Elliptical Pools:

$L \times W \times D \times 5.9 =$ Gallons

DIRECTIONS

When you determine the gallonage of your pool refer above for the amount needed for control of algae. Add HYAGEN to the pool by pouring evenly around the edge of the pool. The addition of HYAGEN requires no waiting time before swimming.

For control of algae growth and slime, add an initial dosage directly to the pool at the rate of 1 gallon to each 50,000 gallons of water. Add a maintenance dose at least every 7 days of 1 quart of HYAGEN to 50,000 gallons of water. Be certain pool is filled to original level. If make-up water is added at rate of more than 10% per week of pool capacity add 1 quart of HYAGEN for each 10,000 gallons of fresh make up water added per week.

RINSE EMPTY CONTAINER THOROUGHLY WITH WATER AND DISCARD IT
