The updated formula statement is acceptable. It is understood that the formula dated September 10, 1987 replaces previously accepted formulas for this product.

The revised labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, is acceptable provided that you:

1. Make the following change before releasing the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

- Under Hazards to Humans add the statements:

Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse.

Properly balanced and chlorinated swimming pool water should be maintained. However, there are times when water conditions may allow algae to grow. Sanygen Cuprogen Algaecide will inhibit the growth of algae and return water to normal when used as directed.

DIRECTIONS: Distribute SANYGEN CUPROGEN ALGAECIDE evenly over the filter operating. Add the amount indicated in the dosage chart to 18,000 gallons of swimming pool water.

Apply to a pool free of visible algae. For heavy algae infestations, such as superchlorination with SANYGEN SUPER SHOCK may be necessary to remove the algae. Follow all directions for superchlorination on SANYGEN SUPER SHOCK.

To maintain pools free of visible algae growth, subsequent applications of CUPROGEN ALGAECIDE should be made every 2 weeks after the first application. See the dosage chart for the correct maintenance dosage.

HOW TO ESTIMATE POOL GALLONAGE: Measure pool length (L) in feet, average depth (D) in feet for square or rectangular pools, pool gallonage equals $L \times W \times D \times 7.5$. For round or oval pools, pool gallonage equals $L \times W \times D \times 7.5$.
